Notice to Industry

AQIS requires the Customs Brokers Licence Number from BAS Accredited Persons

Who is affected by this notice?

Persons who obtain AQIS accreditation under the Containerised Cargo Clearance (CCC) for FCL/X Scheme, Automatic Entry Processing (AEP) for FCL Scheme and/or LCL Packing Scheme (collectively known as the Broker Accreditation Schemes–BAS) **prior to** obtaining their Australian Customs Service Customs Broker's Licence.

What is required?

If you currently hold AQIS BAS accreditation, when you receive notification of your Customs Broker's Licence number you will need to provide AQIS with your licence number, your AQIS accreditation number and your current contact details. These details should be emailed to brokeraccred@aqis.gov.au

Why is this information required?

Providing this information means AQIS can activate your AQIS accreditation against your Customs Broker's Licence in the Integrated Cargo System (ICS) and ensures AQIS has current accredited person's records

The activation of your AQIS accreditation in the ICS will allow you to lodge import declarations under the CCC for FCL/X Scheme, AEP for FCL Scheme and/or LCL Packing Scheme.

Please note: AQIS has been responsible for activating the AQIS accreditation of licensed brokers in the ICS since its introduction.
