IMPORT RISK ANALYSIS: PIGEONS ADOPTION OF REVISED CONDITIONS

Animal Quarantine Policy Memorandum (AQPM) 1999/39 of 8 June 1999 provided finalised quarantine requirements for the importation of pigeons. Following announcement of the final conditions, there was a 30 day period during which stakeholders had the opportunity to appeal against the process under which the import risk analysis was conducted.

No appeals were received from stakeholders and as a result the conditions attached to AQPM 1999/39 will be adopted on 16 July 1999.
