EXPLANATORY NOTES:

EU animals sent to agricultural shows, camp drafts and similar events may have their EU status re-instated on their return home after the transfer has taken place in the NLIS database.

EU animals sent on agistment to a non-EU property may only have their EU status re-instated if prior approval was granted by AQIS.

Ineligible non-EU breeders may be sent to shows and on agistment etc, but they must remain as non-EU in the system.

Please advise us whether any calves were born or tags lost while away from your property.

You will need to supply a list of the animals RFID / NLIS numbers before their status can be re-instated. If there are 20 animals or less, you may provide a written list (hard copy). If there are more than 20 animals you must supply the list electronically in Excel format to eucas@aqis.gov.au
