PLANT BIOSECURITY POLICY MEMORANDUM 2001/24

GLOBAL IMPORT RISK ANALYSIS – FRESH PINEAPPLE FRUIT

This Plant Biosecurity Policy Memorandum (PBPM) provides stakeholders with information on a workshop with stakeholders regarding the Global Import Risk Analysis (IRA) on fresh pineapple fruit.

As part of the ongoing consultative process, a second workshop with stakeholders will be held to discuss the progress of the Global IRA for the import of fresh pineapple. The workshop will be held on 14 January 2002 at the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service Offices, Brisbane at 42-44 Qantas Drive, Eagle Farm from 2 pm until 5 pm.

At the workshop there will be a presentation of the test results of the methyl bromide treatment trials, the completed pest categorisation and proposed revisions to existing measures for mitigating risk.
