## **Purpose**

To provide exporters with an opportunity to notify AQIS of interest in gaining accreditation for the export of breeding animals and/or reproductive material to Chile.

## **Background**

Any breeding centre or registered premise wishing to export breeding animals or reproductive material to Chile must be accredited by Servicio Agrícola y Ganadero (SAG). To date SAG have visited Australia to accredit establishments. SAG accreditation is for a period of two years. The cost of the visit/accreditation is split between all establishments included in the visit.

AQIS have recently been notified by SAG of Chilean interest in importing Australian cattle and genetics.

Please note that SAG only accept animals and reproductive material from the bluetongue free zone of Australia.

## Instructions

Exporters interested in seeking SAG accreditation are to provide written notification of interest to AQIS-Canberra by 21 November 2007.
