

Interim standard response

The Australian Government shares community concerns about animal welfare issues in the live export industry.

---

The Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry, Senator the Hon. Joe Ludwig, wrote to the live export industry in January 2011, asking it for options to improve animal welfare practices in importing countries. The industry has provided its plans to the Government, and these plans are currently being considered.

---

The footage of serious animal welfare abuses, concerning Australian cattle exported to Indonesia, is extremely disturbing. This footage shows practices which fall well below standards expected by the Australian community.

Minister Ludwig has asked the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry to urgently investigate this footage, and to provide advice to the Government on what further actions should be taken in response.

Your concerns in relation to this important issue have been noted.
