

APPENDIX D: IUCN THREAT RATINGS FOR LOWER RISK AND DATA DEFICIENT PLANTS

Plants rated as Lower Risk in the Gippsland Region

A taxon is rated as Lower Risk if there was sufficient information to answer a particular rule but was not categorised as Critically Endangered, Endangered or Vulnerable. Taxa rated as lower risk can be considered secure in Gippsland and not at risk of extinction in the foreseeable future.
