Emailed Directions

The purpose of this notice is to advise industry of changes to information included on emailed directions sent after documents are processed.

Why did AQIS change the content of its emailed directions?

Feedback has identified that the inclusion of additional information on the existing emailed direction template would be beneficial to industry and AQIS.

When will the new email notifications be available?

Testing has been successfully completed and the upgrade to AIMS is due to take place on 7 October 2008. The new email directions will be available from 8 October 2008.

Introduction of the new email direction format has been timed to coincide with the expansion of electronic lodgement of documentation via email.

What information has been added?

Email directions will include all information relating to lines including the line number, product description, tariff code, quantity, package type and country of origin.

Examples of a Final Release From Quarantine (**Example A**) and a Quarantine Order (**Example B**) are shown below.

AQIS Quarantine Order
