IMPORT RISK ANALYSIS: HATCHING EGGS OF DOMESTIC DUCKS ADOPTION OF REVISED CONDITIONS

Animal Quarantine Policy Memorandum (AQPM) 1999/23 of 30 March 1999 provided finalised quarantine requirements for the importation of hatching eggs of domestic ducks. There was an appeal period until 30 April 1999 for stakeholders to appeal against the process under which the import risk analysis was conducted.

One appeal was received which was subsequently withdrawn. As a result the conditions attached to AQPM 1999/23 can now be adopted.
