## ANIMAL BIOSECURITY POLICY MEMORANDUM 2002/47

### IMPORTATION OF BOVINE SEMEN FROM BRAZIL DECISION ON QUARANTINE CONDITIONS

This Animal Biosecurity Policy Memorandum (ABPM) provides final quarantine requirements for the importation of bovine semen from Brazil (Attachment A). The conditions come into effect on 4 November 2002.

Animal Biosecurity proposed draft quarantine requirements for the importation of bovine semen from Brazil in ABPM 2002/24 of 20 May 2002. One stakeholder responded without substantive comment. As a result the attached final conditions are unchanged from the draft requirements circulated in May 2002.

#### Next steps

These conditions come into effect on 4 November 2002.
