IMPORT RISK ANALYSIS: IMPORTATION OF RHINOCEROS FROM SOUTH AFRICA ADOPTION OF REVISED CONDITIONS

Animal Quarantine Policy Memorandum (AQPM) 1999/49 of 9 July 1999 provided finalised quarantine requirements for the importation of rhinoceros from South Africa. Following announcement of the final conditions, there was a 30 day period during which stakeholders had the opportunity to appeal against the process under which the import risk analysis was conducted.

No appeals were received from stakeholders and as a result the conditions attached to AQPM 1999/49 will be adopted today, 16 August 1999.
