Additional Requirements and Information	<p>Certification:</p> <p>The health certificates should be signed on or before the date of departure. If a replacement Health Certificate is issued after departure the "in lieu of" clause on the replacement Health Certificate should reference the Health Certificate issued on or before departure.</p> <p>Letters of facilitation have been rejected by China. Care should be taken regarding letter of credit arrangements to ensure that they do not conflict with export Certification Requirements. Information regarding Chinese quarantine procedures and contacts was advised by email on 8/5/03.</p> <p>The ZDCN01 and the ZDCN02 certificates can only be printed in AQIS offices.</p> <p>Product Standards:</p> <p>There is a maximum allowable level of 1g/kg of sorbic acid in cheese and 0.5g/kg of sorbic acid in beverages containing milk.</p> <p>Samples for Expos:</p> <p>The Chinese AQSIQ Food Safety Bureau has requested that exporters and exhibitors intending to send samples to dairy expos make necessary preparations well in advance for their own benefit. Importers are required to notify AQSIQ Food Safety Bureau with product details, variety, specifications and quantity so that inspection and clearance can be made in time for the expositions.</p> <p>Labelling:</p> <p>See Dairy Industry Notice 2007 – 05 issued on 17/12/07 for labelling requirements. <p>Transit Certification Requirements</p>	<p>Milk and milk products transiting the European Union or the United States may require transit documentation. For product transiting the European Union via seafreight a DS054 certificate is provided and for product transiting the European Union via airfreight a DA054 certificate is provided. These certificates are available as additional certificates through the EXDOC system and are required to be signed by AQIS officers in a different colour ink to that of the printing of the certificate. If the product is transiting the United States standard certification is required and the exporter should contact the DRU for advice on how this certification may be issued.</p>
