Additional Requirements and Information	AQIS has received information that product exported to the Russian Federation for human consumption must have a label in the Russian language. Bulk products are exempt from this requirement.
Establishment listing requirements	Establishments must be listed by the Russian Federation Veterinary Service (Rosselkhoznadzor) to be eligible to export milk and milk products to the Russian Federation. For exports of all prescribed edible product	Please include a tick in the 'Declaration of Compliance' and 'Info True and Complete' boxes. If the RFP contains imported product please include a tick in the "Imported Product Flag" box and advise in the email the nature of the imported dairy ingredient including percentage in the product and country of origin.

Substantiation requirements	Declaration of Compliance Transfer documentation Russian Federation microbiological requirements must be met through inclusion in the establishments' Approved Arrangement – details of Russian Federation microbiological requirements are attached .
Transit Certification Requirements	Milk and milk products transiting the European Union or the United States may require transit documentation. These certificates are available as additional certificates through the EXDOC system. If the product is transiting the United States, standard certification is required and the exporter should contact the DRU for advice on how this certification may be issued. If the product is transiting a European Union member state, see the particular European Union member state regarding the certificate template to select.

<p>Certification Requirements</p>	<p>All product The Russian Federation Health Certificate must be signed on or before the date of departure. Replacement Health Certificates cannot be issued after the product has left Australia. AQIS may be able to provide a letter addressed to the importing authorities when there is a change of consignee, container number or seal number. This letter may or may not result in consignment clearance. For other changes AQIS may be able to provide assistance, please contact the DRU. The product source state must be provided. Container numbers, seal numbers and product source state must be included in each line of an RFP. Separate health certificates should be issued for each container.</p>
<p>Edible product</p>	<p>On the EX325A Notify Party and Additional Information details will print.</p>
<p>Dairy Goods by Definition</p>	<p>The Russian Federation requires Russian Health Certification for 1. ice cream and 2. dairy products which have a minor component of dairy product that are derived from bovine species. Product in these categories is not ordinarily classified as ‘prescribed’ under the Export Control Act, but where the country concerned requires export certification that refers to registered establishment and all requirements that are needed to be met for other dairy product, then the dairy product is classified as ‘Dairy Goods by Definition’ (DBD), the appropriate DC code is selected and Russian type Health Certification will be provided.</p>
<p>Manufacturing grade product</p>	<p>Manufacturing grade product must come from an export registered establishment. On the EX346A Notify Party and Additional Information details will print.</p>

Stockfood	Certification for stockfood product is unknown.
Non prescribed goods	If you wish to export dairy products that are derived from non bovine species (such as from sheep and goats) please check the current status of this issue with AQIS. At this stage the relevant health certificate hasn't been negotiated with the Russian authorities, the code NPG is used and a ZD001 Dairy Certificate as to Condition will be provided.
